

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL BEHAVIOUR POLICY



The Directors of the Governing Body of Hadrian Academy Trust have agreed that policy documentation from Hadrian Lower School will continue to be appropriate until such time that the policy is due to be updated.

Note;

- The wording Hadrian Lower School should be read as Hadrian Academy.
- Reference to the Local Authority may not always apply.
- Reference to staff employer should be read as Hadrian Academy Trust.

The aim of this policy is to;

1. improve the atmosphere and safety for all children and parents on arrival and departure at the end of the school day
2. ensure expectations are fully understood
3. ensure roles and responsibilities are clear

Safety and Atmosphere

Whilst sharing a few minutes socialising before school all children and parents have the right to gather on the playground. This must be in complete safety from balls, bikes and scooters. Parents and children must not be subject to inappropriate language such as swearing from children or adults.

If our children have a pleasant start to the day this will have a positive impact on their learning.

Expectations

Behaving appropriately – Swearing is not acceptable by pupils, parents or visitors.

Climbing frame and field – Children must not use before or after school unless attending a club. Please ensure toddlers are kept off apparatus at all times.

Bikes and scooters - Bikes and scooters must not be used on the playground. They must be secured on the Hadrian Avenue fencing if left at school during the day.

Football - Not allowed before or after school in the playground. It is too crowded and someone may get hit. Children may play football every lunch time and most playtimes when the grass area is in use or split Key Stage playtimes.

Parking – We ask that parents show consideration by not parking across drives or verges

No Smoking – No smoking on school site at any time. No smoking policy has been enforced since July 2007.

Roles and Responsibilities

Parents are responsible for pupils until 8.50am and after 3.15pm. The school does not operate a duty system before or after school and therefore the children are the responsibility of parents/carers. For Foundation pupils 9.00 am and 3.10 pm.

Younger brothers and sisters

It is the parents responsibility to ensure they do not go onto the climbing frame or ride scooters / bikes on school grounds.

Headteacher or teaching staff – If they observe or are informed reliably by an adult that a child has been seen on the climbing frame, playing football, riding a bike or not behaving appropriately, they will act on this information.

Children will be;

- in the first instance asked not to do it and informed of the rule

- in the second instance reminded of the rule and their parents informed
- in the third instance the child will receive a consequence for their behaviour and lose some of their Golden time and parents will be invited in for a meeting

This policy will be reviewed annually.
